Web Hosting customers will need to sign up for a Web Hosting account and purchase a domain name. Internet Explorer 6 or any other FTP (File Transfer Protocol) program can be used to upload files to the server. Specific uploading instructions for the FTP feature on Internet Explorer for either your free space or Web Hosting account are listed below the basic FTP information on this page. If you haven't designed your website yet and need help, Paul Bunyan Net does have a web design service.

Basic FTP Information

This information can be used with any FTP program or website design software with an upload feature. The format with which the information is put into the program depends on the program. Please consult your documentation or help files for the software you are using.

Note: You must contact us to activate this service or to get additional server space. You will also need your Dial-up or High Speed Internet (DSL) username and password in order to login.

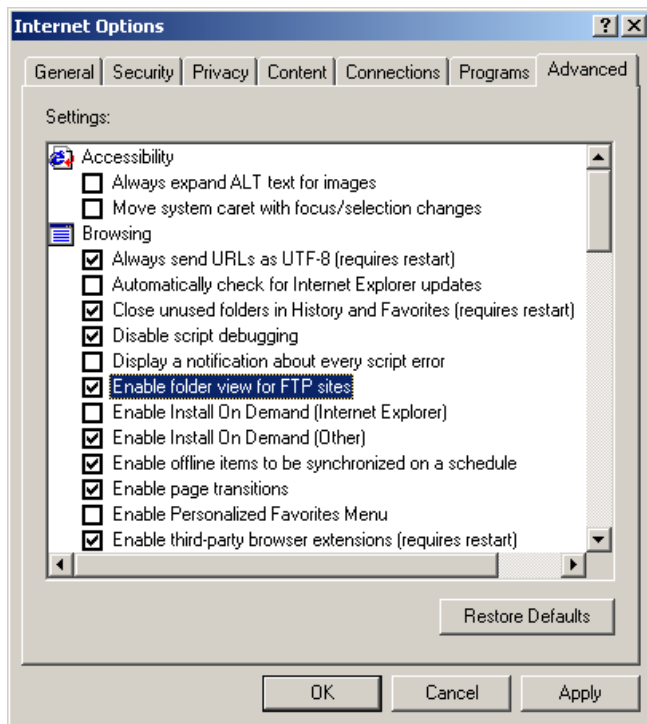

Note: You will also need your Web Hosting username and password in order to login.

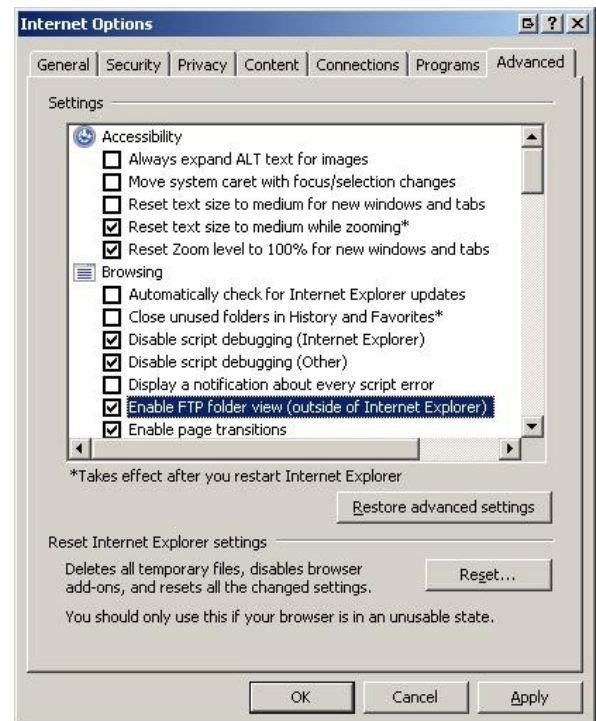
Internet Explorer 6

- > Open *Internet Explorer*.
- > Click “**Tools**” at the top of the screen.
- > Select “**Internet Options**”.
- > Click the “**Advanced**” tab.
- > Make sure the “**Enable folder view for FTP sites**” box is checked.
- > Click “**OK**”.



Internet Explorer 7

- > Open *Internet Explorer*.
- > Click “**Tools**” at the top of the screen.
- > Select “**Internet Options**”.
- > Click the “**Advanced**” tab.
- > Make sure the “**Enable FTP folder view**” box is checked.
- > Click “**OK**”.



Free Space

- > Enter “*ftp://yourusername@www.paulbunyan.net/www*” in the address bar.

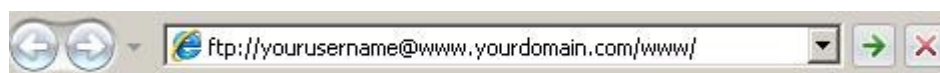
Replace the “**yourusername**” with your dialup or email username at Paul Bunyan Net.



Web Hosting

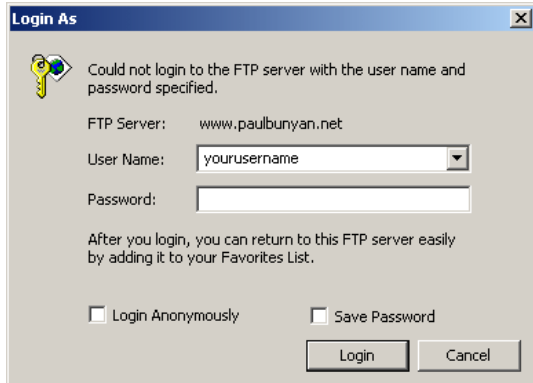
- > Enter “*ftp://yourusername@www.yourdomain.com/www*” in the address bar.

Replace the “**yourusername**” with your hosting username at Paul Bunyan Net.
Replace the “**yourdomain.com**” with your registered domain name.



Internet Explorer 6

- > Type your password next to "Password:".
- > Click "Login".

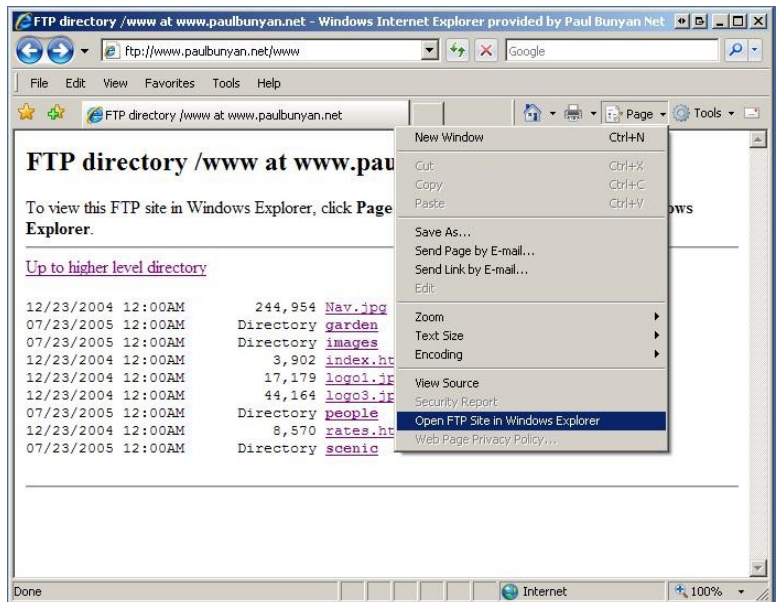


Internet Explorer 7

- > Type your password next to "Password:".
- > Click "Log On".



- > Click on the "Page" menu.
- > Select "Open FTP Site in Windows Explorer".



- > Your files will be displayed like a normal Windows folder.
 - > To upload your files, simply drag and drop the files into this window.
- Note: To edit these files, copy them to a folder on your computer. You can then copy the changed files back to this window.*
